Financial Commitment of the Hospital

This UTAR Hospital is founded along the same guiding principle as the University, that is, a private not-for-profit Hospital that is funded by the generosity of philanthropists, donors, organisations, corporations and members of the community. Hence, UTAR has been actively sourcing support from the people to contribute towards the Hospital building fund. This noble cause has received tremendous support from various segments of the community and UTAR is indeed grateful for all the generous contributions, regardless of the amount.

In Phase 1 of the Hospital, there will be 250 beds in the main block and 100 beds in the TCM block. The TCM Block and staff quarters are expected to be operational before the

end of 2021. The Western Medicine block is expected to be operational in the second half of 2022.

This Hospital development is estimated to cost about RM330 million which includes the Cost of Construction, Sourcing of Medical Equipment and Project Consultancy Cost.
